Our objective is to have a cow herd that averages 500kgs, is quiet and gets around the hills.

Our cows are set stocked with the ewes over calving on steep hill country.

We mate our 15-month heifers. All male calves are sold at weaning.

When selecting bulls, we have been trying to select bulls that are below average for mature weight, birth weight below average, 200-day weight above average, IMF in the top 25% and Rib fat above average.

Temperament must be good and structural soundness is important.
